For those of you who are attending Nationals, I look forward to seeing and competing with you! Go MassJCL!

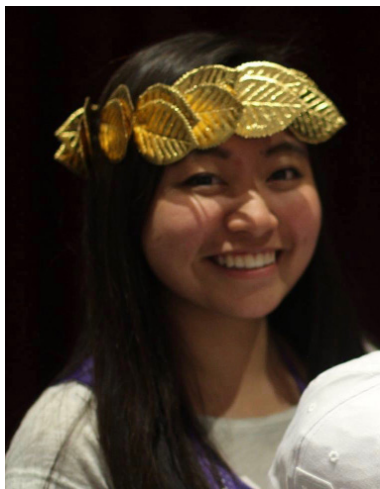

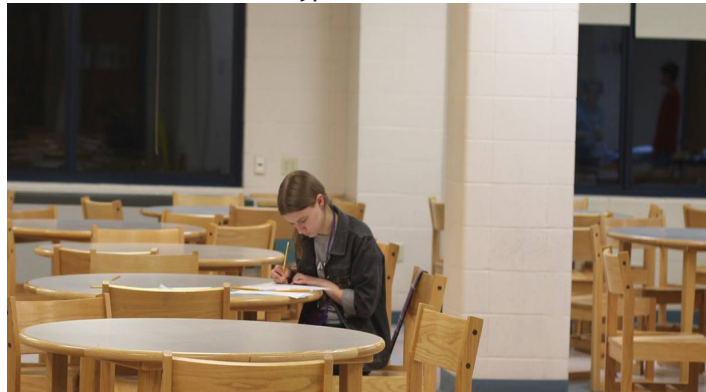

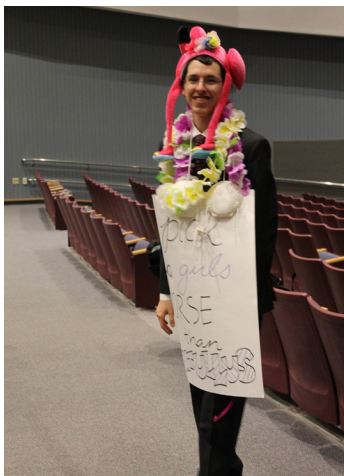
