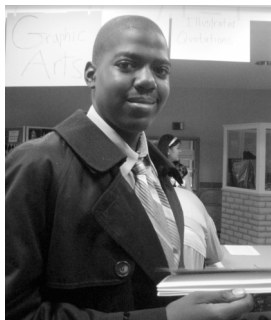

Have a great summer and I hope to see many of you at next year's state convention, or even sooner (Nationals!).



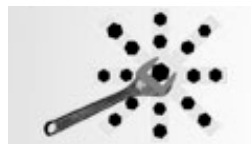

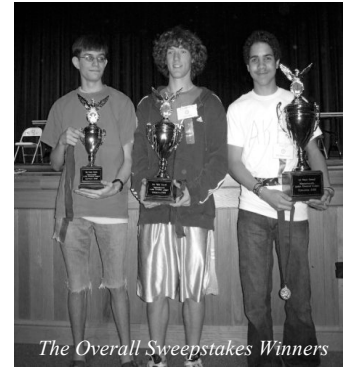
